#### What size skip do I need?

### Where can I put the skip?

#### Can I put one on the street outside my house?

You will need a permit if the skip is to be placed on a public highway we can apply for this on your behalf.





### I have a narrow driveway, how much space do I need for a skip?

Our mini skip size is 2 yards and we need a minimum width of 2.8 metres for delivery.

### What can I put into my skip?

Anything non-hazardous: garden waste, soil, bricks, rubble, general household waste, wood, cardboard, plastics, metal, old furniture, bathroom and kitchen fitments.
